Qualifications:

- Bachelor's or master's degree with a maximum of 2 years of relevant experience.
- Educational background in education, instructional design, communication, business, development studies, public policy, or other related fields.
- Strong interest and relevant experience in training needs assessment, curriculum and module development, instructional design, facilitation, and learning evaluation.
- Ability to develop tailored training concepts, proposals, learning materials, session plans, and interactive learning activities for different participants and institutional needs.
- Experience in coordinating training programs and collaborating with trainers, subject-matter experts, partners, clients, and participants.
- Interest or experience in business development, partnership outreach, client engagement, or promoting professional training and capacity-building programs is a strong advantage.
- Ability to prepare engaging promotional materials, training catalogues, presentations, concept notes, and digital content to expand the reach of RDI's training programs.
- Excellent communication skills in both Indonesian and English, essential for maintaining positive relationships with team members, partners, clients, and stakeholders.

Responsibilities:

- Supporting training implementation, participant engagement, documentation, evaluation, and continuous improvement.
- Developing new training topics, formats, proposals, service packages, and promotional materials based on emerging needs.
- Promoting RDI's training programs and building relationships with potential clients, partners, and professional networks.
- Willing to work from the office (WFO) in Bandung if selected.

This position is based in Bandung. The salary range is IDR 5-7 million/month and will be determined based on the officer's educational background and years of relevant experience. Successful candidates will be contracted for 6 months, from August 2026 to January 2027, with the possibility of an extension subject to project funding.
