Qualifications:

- Bachelor's or master's degree with 1-3 years of relevant experience.
- Educational background in economics, economic development, and other relevant backgrounds.
- Experience and high interest in development economics and policy research, public economics, disaster risk financing, social protection financing, and innovative financing.
- Excellent communication skills in both Indonesian and English are essential for engaging with team members, partners, and stakeholders.
- Possess a strong growth mindset, solid analytical skills (particularly in quantitative analysis), proficiency in quantitative data processing applications (e.g., STATA or SPSS), sharp critical thinking, and excellent academic writing skills.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for proposal writing, research, and project consulting on economics-related topics under the Center for Financing Adaptation, Innovation, and Resilience in RDI.
- Ensuring that the deliverables from the projects mentioned are of high quality and can be produced promptly.
- Support other RDI programs related to research, projects, and academics.
- Analyze research findings, generate comprehensive reports, and provide valuable insights for research project planning and execution.
- Collaborate with other researchers and project teams to design and execute research projects.
- Willing to work from the office (WFO) in Bandung if selected.

This position is based in Bandung. The salary range is IDR 5-7 million/month and will be determined based on the officer's educational background and years of relevant experience. Successful candidates will be contracted for 6 months, from July to December 2026, with the possibility of an extension subject to project funding.
